Meaning of Overcomer

Overcomer - someone who overcomes and establishes ascendancy (Superiority or decisive advantage) and control by force or persuasion

To overcome there is got to be a realisation that where you are, is not where you should be.

How the desire to overcome comes to bear

1. Frustrated with your current status –

Luke 15:17 (Amplified Bible)

¹⁷Then when he came to himself, he said, How many hired servants of my father have enough food, and [even food] to spare, but I am perishing (dying) here of hunger!

2. Realisation of who I am i.e. revelation knowledge of my status

Hosea 6:3 (King James Version)

³Then shall we know, if we follow on to know the LORD: his going forth is prepared as the morning; and he shall come unto us as the rain, as the latter and former rain unto the earth.

3. Strong desire to live in the revelation i.e. no longer a myth

John 8:32 (Amplified Bible)

³²And you will know the Truth, and the Truth will set you free.

4. willingness to pay the price

Isaiah 1:19 (New International Version)

¹⁹ If you are willing and obedient,
you will eat the best from the land;

Qualities of an Overcomer

1. No turning back – i.e. set your face as a flint

Luke 9:62 (New International Version)

⁶²Jesus replied, "No one who puts his hand to the plow and looks back is fit for service in the kingdom of God."

Isaiah 50:7 (New International Version)

⁷ Because the Sovereign LORD helps me, I will not be disgraced. Therefore have I set my face like flint, and I know I will not be put to shame.

2. Maintains his new position i.e. it is not a temporary status

- Maintain your confession i.e. Act it, Talk it, Live it & Walk it
